National Status: Vulnerable, Not Scarce, Native

S Hants: Probably extinct

There are 19th-century records for the Avon and Test valleys, and a less convincing one for Portchester in 1919. The last documented records are from Pussex Lane, Hurn (SZ1297) in 1929. There is a record held on the Hampshire Biodiversity Information Centre database for Pitts Deep in 1986 which is suspected of being a transcription error, since there is no mention of such a significant find by Paul Bowman in the source material for the 1996 *Flora*.

N Hants: Rare Native

Recent records are confined to three areas in botanically-rich wet fens. It might be argued that King John's Meadow is a separate site as it is physically separated from the main part of Greywell Fen by a road, but they both share the same fen habitat adjacent to the River Whitewater. There are also 19th century records for Longparish Marsh (SU44H or G or M), Bransbury (SU44A or B) where it was said to be plentiful, Itchen Stoke (SU53L or R) and 'Near Farnborough' (SU85). Apart from the record for North Warnborough Marsh given below from Rayner's Supplement to Townsend's Flora, Rayner separately gives records for 'Side of Odiham Canal' and 'Greywell'.
